Wooden Caddy #60066

## Brushes:

### Papillon by the Artist's Club

Angular Shader, size ½" #20111; size ¾" #20113; size 5/8" #20112; size 3/8" #20110; size 1" #20114  
Filbert, size 4 #20117  
Shader, size 4 #20126  
Stipple Set #20172

## Preparation:

Sand and seal the wood with DecoArt MultiPurpose Sealer. When dry, sand again and remove any sanding dust with a damp cloth.

Basecoat the surface as follows:

Evergreen – inside of caddy, sides and handle

Soft Black – flyspeck on areas painted Evergreen

Sand – front and back of caddy, and flyspeck the areas painted Evergreen

Transfer the main pattern lines to the front of the caddy.

Milk Chocolate – float shading around outside edges of front & back of the caddy. Float shadings on lower right side under the shovel handle and on the lower right sides under the seed packets.



## Painting Instructions:

### Shovel

Milk Chocolate – handle

Neutral Grey – shovel

Sand – stipple highlight down center of handle

Dark Chocolate – float shading down both edges of handle

Payne's Grey – stipple shading slightly in the center of shovel, where the wood handle meets, and behind the seed packet

Titanium White – float highlight down shovel's outer edge opposite the shaded edge. Stipple highlights where metal meets the wooden handle. With thinned Titanium White, dash highlight lines down center of wooden and metal handle.

### Seed Packets:

Desert Sand – seed packets

Milk Chocolate – flat shading down left side and across the bottom of the packets

### Carrots & Pumpkin

Tangelo Orange – carrots & pumpkin

Burnt Orange – float shading on back carrot against the front one, and on the pumpkin shade the back sections against the front one

Tangerine – stipple highlights on the right sides of both carrots, center of front section of pumpkin and toward the bottom of the side sections

Lemon Yellow – stipple a second highlight on the Tangerine highlights, but keep this color smaller

Burnt Orange – line the carrots

Lemon Yellow – line small highlight lines under the Burnt Orange lines

### **Pumpkin Leaves & Carrot Tops**

Hauser Medium Green – large leaf on pumpkin  
Evergreen – float shading down vein line on top right side of leaf and stipple top on back carrot  
Hauser Medium Green – stipple front carrot top  
Evergreen – line the carrot top stems  
Permanent Pen – write the words “Pumpkin Carrot Seeds and 5”;



### **Gloves**

Winter Blue – center and 4 fingers of gloves  
Buttermilk – thumbs and wrist sections of gloves  
Deep Midnight Blue – shade gloves behind thumbs and lightly down left side of fingers on the blue sections of the gloves  
Titanium White – stipple highlight in center of gloves, then add dots, stipple highlight on center of thumb and wrist areas  
Neutral Grey – float shading on the thumb and wrist areas



### **Gardening**

Soft Black – Using the size 4 Shader brush and very little paint, paint the word “Gardening”

### **Branches, Leaves and Berries**

Dark Chocolate – Load the liner brush with thinned paint. While holding the brush loosely, drag brush along while turning it slightly back and forth to create the branches

Hauser Medium Green – double load the size 4 Filbert brush with Lemon Yellow and Evergreen and stroke on the small leaves

Country Red – Make dot berries in one, two and three dot clusters

### **Finishing:**

Erase all remaining transfer lines.

With the permanent pen, outline your work as much as you like.

Finish with several light coats of spray varnish.



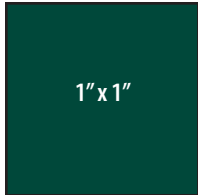
# Pattern at 100%
