## Preparation:

Sand and seal the wood pieces with DecoArt MultiPurpose Sealer. Sand again when dry and wipe away any sanding dust with a damp cloth. Transfer the line for the hatband and top of face and basecoat as follows:

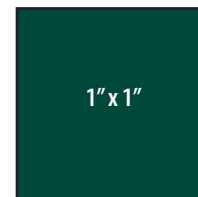
Deep Midnight Blue – face area

Santa Red – hatband

Graphite – hat and brim

Burnt Orange – nose

Spicy Mustard – star



To ensure your pattern is at 100%, this box should measure 1" x 1" when printed.

Warm White – stipple face

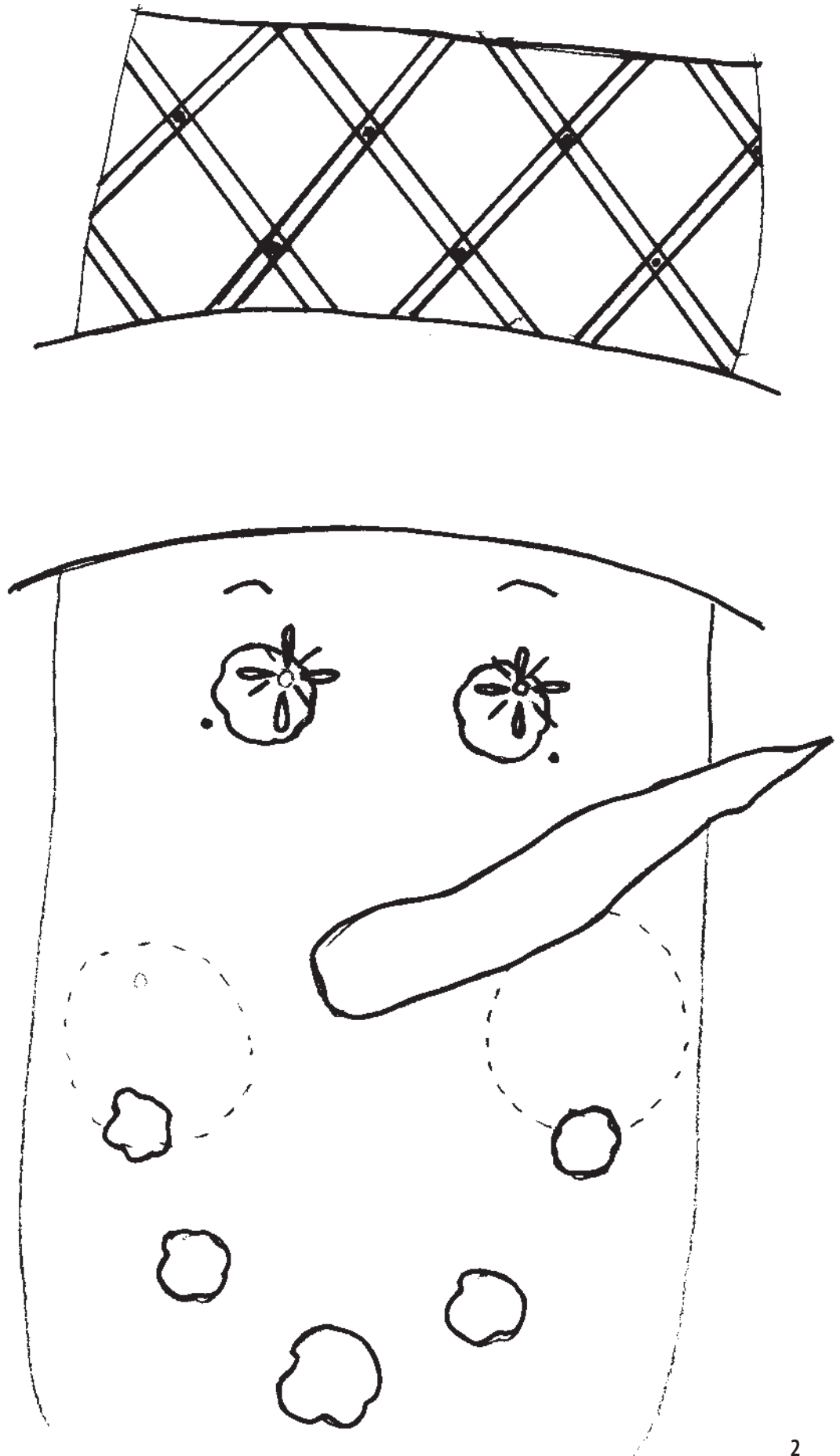
## Pattern at 100%

### Painting Instructions:

Shade the face, at the top and down both sides slightly, and drybrush shading where the eyes and mouth rocks will be with Victorian Blue. Stipple again lightly all over the face with Warm White. Blush the cheeks with Antique Rose. Shade the base and bottom of the nose with Antique Maroon and highlight the tip with Hot Shots Fiery Red. The eyes, eyebrows, and mouth rocks are Lamp Black. Highlight the right side of the eyes with “snowflakes”, the top of the cheeks with dots, and some of the mouth rocks with dots, all using Warm White.

Highlight the center of the hatband with Hot Shots Fiery Red, and shade the outer edges with Liquid Shadow. The plaid is lined with Light Avocado, using the size 4 Shader brush. Shade the plaid lines where they intersect with Hauser Dark Green and highlight the centers of the plaid lines with Avocado Dip. Add small dots of Spicy Mustard at the intersections.

Shade the sides of the hat, above the hatband on the hat and both sides of the brim with Lamp Black. Highlight the center of the hat and brim with a dry brush highlight using Warm White. Shade the left side of the star with Burnt Sienna and highlight the right side with Primary Yellow.



### Finishing:

Using Americana Wood Glue, glue the nose to the face; star to the hat toward the top of the hatband; and the hat brim between the face and hatband. Allow to dry well. Finish with several light coats of DecoArt Acrylic Spray Sealer/Finisher – Matte. Cut a length of craft wire and attach it to the top of the hat. Cut a 2" strip of fabric and tie a bow on the wire. Clip the ends of the fabric as desired.
